HORSE SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Proof of negative coggins must be available. 2 years in state, 6 months out of state.
2. No charge for Class 1 or 1A, Fit and Show. Station Judging, Danish Ribbons.
3. Must have valid 4-H Card to receive discount. Must do fit and show.
4. Chaps allowed in all stock seat classes except the 4-H Equitation.
5. Any abusive behavior towards any animal will result in dismissal from the grounds.
6. ASTM_SEI hard hats required for all riders under 19 years of age whenever mounted. Western and Saddle seat riders will not be penalized for wearing a safety helmet.
7. Flat saddles required for jumping classes.
8. Shoes or boots with heels must be worn by all riders.
9. No riding on grounds with halter, lead, or double riding.
10. The show reserves the right to cancel, divide or combine classes.
11. Trophy and six ribbons will be awarded in each class unless otherwise noted.
12. Horses prone to kicking must wear a red ribbon on their tail. Unruly horses may be asked to leave.
13. Same horse and rider combination for high point awards. Must ride in at least two classes in division to get high point award. In the event of tie the show committee has picked a class in the division with the results in that class breaking the tie. In the 4-H division the Fit and Show scores will break the tie.
15. All Dogs must be on a leash at all times and attached to a responsible handler.
16. Ponies are 14.2 hands and under.
17. Prize money will be deducted from show bill. If there is a balance owed a check will be mailed to the exhibitors address on the entry form.
18. Horses are entered at own risk. Camp Marshall or Worcester County 4-H Center, Inc. is not responsible for any damage to horse, rider or other properties at the show.
19. Classes will not be held beyond two minutes.
20. Refunds are issued only for injury/illness to horse or exhibitor and will only be made upon receipt, within 7 days after the end of the show, of a vet certificate or a physician's certificate. Refund checks will be mailed upon submission of said documentation. No refunds will be issued at the show.
21. \$25. fee for returned checks also a \$25 fee for any entry unpaid and requiring a bill to be sent.
22. Junior: a rider under 14 as of first of the year.
Senior: a rider 14-17 years as of the first of the year
Youth: a handler 14 and under as of the first of the year.
Adult: a rider 18 and over as of the first of the year except in
Mini division where an Adult is 15 or older.
23. Hi-Point based on the following point schedule: 1st-10, 2nd-6, 3rd-4, 4th-2, 5th-1, 6th-1/2
24. No riding on soccer field.
25. Stallions may be shown only by exhibitors 19 or older.
26. Schooling and warm-up is permitted in authorized areas and times only. Walk-Trot exhibitors should not be schooling at the canter in the warm-up rings. Courteous behavior is expected from all exhibitors and trainers. Changing of fence height in Ring 1 or Ring 2 is prohibited. The jump in the warm up ring may be adjusted.
27. Horses must be stabled after show hours – no overnight stabling or overnight trailer stabling allowed at Camp Marshall. Anyone in violation will be assessed a fine of \$100.00

BARN RULES

Stall and camp reservations must be pre-registered and prepaid by (see stall reservation form).

Limited amount of stalls, cabins and camping site's with electricity are available. Stalls will be assigned on a first-come, first-paid basis and locations assigned are at the discretion of the Barn Managers.

1. All stalls, cabin and camper reservation fees must be paid in full prior to the show. No blank or post-dated checks will be accepted. Any returned check will cause forfeiture of the stalls and/or camps it covered.
2. All stall reservation forms must list horse's name, exhibitor's name or its use as a tack stall. Reservations not in compliance will be marked incomplete and returned with no consideration of earlier date. Barn Manager reserves the right to limit the number of tack stalls requested.
3. No horses and/or campers will be allowed on the grounds until 3:00 PM. on Friday. Those in violation will not be permitted to unload horses until 3:00 PM. However, you will be permitted to setup stalls and decoration Thursday evening 5pm – 8pm.
4. Refunds for stall reservations only in cases where the Barn Manager has been contacted and notified of the cancellation no later than the MONDAY prior to the show. Refunds will be mailed to the name and address on the form within 1 week of the close of the show.
5. Names and stall numbers will be posted at the show. There is no sub-letting or resale of stalls allowed.
6. No person shall enter any stall other than their own without the express permission of the owner. Violators will be escorted from the show grounds.
7. Do not touch or feed other people's horses without express permission from the owner/exhibitor.
8. Do not block the aisle with cars, equipment or horses.
9. No mounting or riding of horses in the stalls.
10. No smoking is allowed in the immediate area of the barn.
11. No grilling or open fires are permitted anywhere near the barns.
12. Do not overload the electrical outlets or use extension cords in an unsafe manner (ie: strung across the barns or multiple items plugged in at same time).
13. Lights will be shut off in the barns at 11:00 P.M. or one-half hour after the last class of the evening is completed, whichever comes first.
14. Bedding is not provided. You may bring your own or purchase when available from the Barn Manager during posted hours. Manure is to be disposed of in designated areas.
15. Do not block water taps either with show curtains or equipment. All exhibitors in an area may use hoses left on a water tap.
16. **No Washing to be done in barn area. All hosing/washing of horses must be done in the wash area clearly marked on the side of Wells Williams arena. Do not wash in the barn aisles. You must clean up after your horse in the wash and barn areas.**
17. Camp Marshall barns have tack rooms and a loft to store hay and shavings. If you use the loft only use the area directly above your horses stall.
18. **No Trucks, Trailers or Cars** should enter the barn area. **Please unload in the parking area.** Camp Marshall has a Year Round Riding Program throughout the weekdays and weekends. To ensure the safety of all our visitors and horses that live on site, please unload in the parking lot area. No cars or trailers will be allowed to park in the barn area. There is ample parking at the facility. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
19. **All cars must park in designated area ONLY. Trucks and Trailers will be the only ones allowed to park on the ring side of the road—unless you have a handicap plate**
